On Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> at approx lunch time you will travel back to the Coach Drop of Point (Fleet Services) arriving at approx 4pm (a packed lunch will be provided, but NO evening meal. Due to the travelling time and unpredictable conditions times may vary.

**Equipment** – The dress for all weekend will be Blue uniform, green uniform and civilian as directed each day, each Cadet will need to have with them all of the following equipment for the week:-
